

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
April 13, 2011**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on April 13, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Rodger Rohe addressed the Board regarding his neighbor, Armin Bork, and the rototillers, lawn mowers, clocks, tin, mufflers and other metal he has by the fence line. The Board stated that this would be covered under the Langlade County Junk Ordinance and referred Rodger to the County. A copy of these minutes will be forwarded to Rodger Rohe.

Joel Carley inquired as to why his 33 acres of land had been rezoned from A-1 to Forestry for parcel #350.001 and his 2 acres with his home from A-1 to Residential for parcel #340.003. He cannot now get the Farm Preservation credit that he has in the past. The Board did not make the change and Joel should have received notice from the County before they made any change last year. Joel did not receive any notice. Rick will talk to the County regarding the correction.

Daryl Rasmussen asked for Board approval to take the Fire Department's new pickup truck in to have the hydraulics taken off. The fire department has a \$300 gift certificate at Doc's. The Board approved taking off the hydraulics and recommended asking them to pull off the hydraulics and cap it for free and letting them keep the removed hydraulics.

Oath of Office forms were completed by all elected officials.

Assessor Gene Matuszewski was present and the Board of Review was set for Thursday, June 2nd from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m. Gene will let us know when he wants the Open Book.

Jon motioned to appoint Sally Hull as fire department executive secretary for the period 4/15/2011 – 4/14/2012. The rate of pay will continue at \$7.25 per hour and with a maximum of 25 hours per month. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to send a certified letter to Rushmore Loan Management Services, LLC, the bank that took over the property at W8212 Forrest Road, in regard to their violation of the Langlade County Junk Ordinance with their 75 – 100 semi tires on the property. They will be given 60 days to remove the tires. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$5,438.33, savings balance of \$265,189.02 and tax account balance of \$146,777.38 for a total of \$417,404.73.

Jon motioned that the Board send the Langlade County Land Use Planning Committee, the town's approval to rezone back to A-1 Wiley Petroskey's land and Joel Carley's parcel #350.001 and #340.003. Rick seconded. Motion carried. A copy of this request will be forwarded to Becky Frisch.

A motion was made by Jon to reissue the alcohol beverage license for BP North in the name of Draeger Oil Co., Inc. instead of CA Northside, LLC, per the state's request so the name on the license matches the name on the seller's permit. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The Annual Meeting will be held on Thursday, April 14th at 7:30 p.m.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 10th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:40 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
