

**Town of Antigo
Annual Town Meeting
April 14, 2011**

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order on April 14, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Parilek. Twelve town residents were present.

Rick introduced the current elected officials including Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi, Treasurer Cindy Igl, and Constable Daryl Rasmussen. Assessor Gene Matuszewski was also present.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior year's meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Daryl Rasmussen and seconded by Tom Dieck. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 10 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Town's 2010 Annual Financial Report was reviewed. Daryl Rasmussen motioned to accept the financial report as presented. Cindy Igl seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 12 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Mike Winski was present from the fire department and stated that the department has been very lucky in receiving grants and are always looking for new members.

Jon Petroskey, Fire Chief for the City of Antigo, gave the ambulance report. They had 1,658 calls in 2010 compared to 1,807 in 2009. Of those calls, 34 of them were in the Town of Antigo compared to 51 in 2009. Jon explained the formula for billing towns for their share of the ambulance budget.

Rick explained the state's new road sign reflectivity standards. This will be a 5 to 6 year phase in. Each sign must be inspected and replaced if not up to code. The County charges \$60 per man hour plus \$60 per hour to use their reflectivity test equipment. The Board would be willing to do the testing visually, which is an accepted method if 1 of the 2 persons testing is over age 65. Rick estimated the town would save about \$16,200 by having the Board test and update the signs.

Mike Winski motioned to authorize the town board to hire elected officials for road mowing, spraying weeds, road patching, cutting trees, storm clean up or road signing for \$12 per hour including mileage. Daryl Rasmussen seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 12 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Rick stated that a written request was received from the Town of Antigo Little League team asking for a donation and stating that they will clean town roadways. No request has been received from the Spring Valley Little League team to date. Daryl Rasmussen motioned to donate \$500 to the Town of Antigo Little League team and \$300 to the Spring Valley Little League team if a written request is received from them. Gene Matuszewski seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 12 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

A motion to set next year's annual meeting on Thursday, April 12, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. was made by Daryl Rasmussen and seconded by Tom Dieck. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 12 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn at 8:05 p.m. by Tom Dieck. Mary Dieck seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 12 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.
