

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
April 9, 2008**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on April 9, 2008 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. There were 3 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

Donald Yaggie, from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, was present and asked the Board if they would like to get in on their oil allotment that they have now that is less expensive. When Fahrner purchases additional oil, it will be more expensive and will affect the prices they would give us later on for requested work. Fahrner proposed chip sealing Forest Road for \$19,139 and Clover Road for \$21,346 for a total of \$40,485. He also proposed crack sealing Stoney Road for \$739, the north half-mile of Orchard Road for \$924, Trillium Lane for \$476 and crack sealing and infra-red patching of the town hall lot for \$3,105 for a total of \$5,244. Total of proposed work is \$45,729. Rick motioned to accept both proposals as presented totaling \$45,729. Jon seconded. There were 3 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

Dan Hafner was sworn in as the Town of Antigo Fire Chief.

Dan stated that Holly Hayes wants to do EMS but does not want to take the required Firefighter 1 course. The fire department by-laws state that this class must be completed. Holly wants the fire department and Board to change the fire department by-laws so she does not have to take the course. The Board and Fire Chief unanimously agreed that the fire department by-laws should not be changed for safety and liability reasons.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$45,184.82, savings balance of \$140,416.58, and tax account balance of \$134,358.68 for a total of \$320,005.08.

Town resident Vern Raab was present and expressed his concern regarding the blacktopping of Clover Road, spring ditching in the Town and a County grader plowing the roads.

Jon motioned to appoint Leah Igl as fire department executive secretary for the period 4/15/2008 to 4/14/2009. The rate of pay will be \$6.55 per hour and continue with a maximum of 25 hours per month. Wayne seconded. There were 3 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to attach the town hall lawn maintenance to the building maintenance position currently held by Mike Winski. The lawn maintenance hours would not affect the 15 hour maximum per month for building maintenance. The hourly rate will be \$10 for all work. Wayne seconded. There were 3 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Annual Town Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 15th at 7:30 p.m.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 13th at 7:30 p.m.

The Board of Review is tentatively set for Tuesday, June 3rd from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.

All bills approved were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:55 p.m. Jon seconded. There were 3 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.
