

**Town of Antigo  
Town Board Meeting  
December 16, 2010**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on December 16, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. Rick added that he checked with Becky Frisch regarding Rodger Rohe's complaints with Armin Bork. She told Rick that the vehicle with the snowplow on it has been grandfathered in. In regard to the junk ordinance violations, Becky will not be going back unless she has a court order. Being no further additions, the minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.
