

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
February 10, 2009**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on February 10, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. It was noted that our February meeting was changed to February 10th instead of February 11th. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Surveyor Tim Rusch and Leo Starzinski were present and addressed the Board regarding Leo's proposed request to rezone his land at 608 Dorr Street. There have been complaints brought to the County regarding this site where Leo recycles aluminum cans. These complaints made the County aware that this property is not properly zoned and also that it is located in a flood plane. Leo Starzinski will be applying to the Langlade County Water & Land Use Committee for a zoning change from residential to industrial and then to the Langlade County Board of Adjustments for a Conditional Use Permit to operate a recycling center or transfer site. The request will be on the agenda for the Town Board Meeting next month. They wanted to bring it to the Town Board so the Board has time to ask questions and look at the site before it is on the agenda.

The treasurer corrected the December treasurer's report to show a checking balance of \$5,181.66, savings balance of \$253,982.70 and tax account interest of \$132.20 for a total of \$259,296.56. The January report shows a checking balance of \$6,567.54, savings balance of \$206,125.87 and tax account interest of \$132.20 for a total of \$212,825.61.

The Board audited the clerk and treasurer's books. The clerk and treasurer's records agreed with each other and the bank statements. The Board agreed that all appeared in order and Jon motioned to approve the audit. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. The Board signed the balance sheet with a net worth of \$294,625.67 as of December 31, 2008.

A motion was made by Wayne to enforce weight limits when posted for: Orchard Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Hwy. F; Clover Road, from Highway 52 to Highway 64; Meadow Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Hwy. F; and Dorr Street, from Cty. Hwy. Y to Cty. Hwy. X. Wayne also motioned to close Schroeder Road when needed. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

There will be a Primary Election on February 17th.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 18th at 7:30 p.m.

The April Board Meeting was tentatively set for Tuesday, April 14th at 7:30 p.m.

The Annual Meeting was tentatively set for Thursday, April 16th at 7:30 p.m.

All bills approved were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:55 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
