

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
February 10, 2010**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on February 10, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Tim Rusch, the surveyor for Antigo Investments LLP, was present in regard to their variance request to create a new parcel of substandard area of .40 acres in a Commercial District located off of Highway 45 North. (Parcel #006-0265.013) Greg and Dennis Schuh own Antigo Investments and have sold the Antigo Fireplace building to a local business owner. They want to separate that lot from their lot next door which has the old True Value Hardware building which Antigo Fireplace will be moving into. All requirements of the County have been met other than the needed variance in lot size. Jon motioned to approve Antigo Investments LLP's variance request to create a new parcel of substandard area of .40 acres in a Commercial District. Wayne seconded. An oral vote was taken. Rick- Aye. Jon ó Aye. Wayne ó Aye. Motion carried. A signed approval recommendation form will be forwarded to Becky Frisch.

The Board received a Public Hearing Notice on Christopher Portman's request for a zoning change from A-2 and R-1 to AFR for Christmas trees and 1 future residence on Langlade Road. (Parcel #006-0493.001 and #006-0511) Jon motioned to approve Christopher Portman's request for a zoning change from A-2 and R-1 to AFR for Christmas trees and 1 future residence. Wayne seconded. An oral vote was taken. Rick ó Aye. Jon ó Aye. Wayne ó Aye. Motion carried. A signed approval recommendation form will be forwarded to Becky Frisch.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$7,256.89, savings balance of \$247,149.66 and tax account interest of \$127.76 for a total of \$254,534.31.

The Board audited the clerk and treasurer's books. The clerk and treasurer's records agreed with each other and the bank statements. The Board agreed that all appeared in order and Wayne motioned to approve the audit. Jon seconded. Motion carried. The Board signed the balance sheet with a net worth of \$345,506.05 as of December 31, 2009.

A motion was made by Jon to enforce weight limits when posted for: Orchard Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Hwy. F, Clover Road, from Highway 52 to Highway 64, Meadow Road, from Highway 64 to Cty. Hwy. F, and Dorr Street, from Cty. Hwy. Y to Cty. Hwy. X. Jon also motioned to close Schroeder Road when needed. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 10th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Jon at 9:40 p.m. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.
