

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
January 13, 2010**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on January 13, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Chris Portman appeared before the Board in regard to his town parcel #06-0511 which is 8.25 acres of Christmas trees now. He would like to split the parcel in approximately half for a future home building site. He is not sure how the parcel is zoned but the town plan shows it as residential. Jon motioned to approved Chris Portman's request to split parcel #06-0511 for a home building site as long as the parcel is 3 acres or more in size. Jon also motioned to approve a rezone request to R-1 or AFR for this parcel if needed for his building request. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the minutes will be forwarded to Becky Frisch.

Wayne motioned to adopt Resolution #4-09, a Resolution to Oppose DOR County Assessment Proposal. Jon seconded. Motion carried. Signed copies of the resolution will be sent to State Representative Donald Friske, State Senator Jim Holperin, the Wisconsin Department of Revenue and the Wisconsin Towns Association.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$7,114.40, savings account balance of \$284,706.80 and tax account balance of \$127.76 for a total of \$291,948.96.

A motion was made by Rick to sign the Joint Powers Agreement County 911 Emergency System with the Langlade County Sheriff's Department. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

Wayne motioned to sign the 2010 Antigo Arborists yard waste contract for \$8,000. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 10th at 7:30 p.m. All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:20 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
