

**Town of Antigo  
Town Board Meeting  
May 13, 2009**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on May 13, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

LeeAnn and Kurt Flood were present in regard to their Conditional Use Permit request for a petting zoo on Neva Road. They are considering purchasing the 5.6 acre property at 1802 Neva Road and building a retail store, a detached shop with 3 bays, renovating the current house for retail and building a small barn. They would like to have 2 draft horses and a petting zoo in the barn. The town would need to allow a variance in the back of the lot for park and recreation. The property is currently zoned commercial and industrial. The Board will wait until an official request comes through and then put it on the Town Board Meeting agenda for action.

Larry Schmoll was present regarding the request from Draeger Oil and Seventh Generation Energy System's Petition for Grant of Variance on the height of two wind turbine towers 150' in height at N4005 Highway 45 North. Larry stated that the power generated would be for their own use. Becky Frisch, from the Langlade County Land Records and Regulations Department, told Rick that since the request is within 3 miles of the Langlade County Airport, it is up to them to decide on the request. All the town can do is submit concerns to the County. The Board is sending Becky a list of their concerns as follows: 1) Creates a driving distraction being so close to the road. 2) Devalue surrounding properties for future retail expansion. 3) Noise concerns. 4) Cosmetic concerns. 5) Lot size for tower height.

Jon motioned to approve alcohol beverage licenses contingent upon no problems for Rick's 45 Roadhouse for the period 5/22/09 to 6/30/09; and Rick's 45 Roadhouse, Amoco North and Neuske's Blackjack Steak House for the period 7/1/09 to 6/30/10. The motion also included approving operator licenses for Nicole Pavek, Vicki Dobratz, Shannon Schultz, Teslynne Van Price and Connie Piotrowski for the period 7/1/09 to 6/30/10. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

Rick motioned to approved Resolution #1-09 Opposing Proposed Changes to Wisconsin Prevailing Wage Law. Jon seconded. Motion carried. Copies of the signed resolution will be sent to Representative Donald Friske and Senator Jim Holperin.

A motion was made by Wayne to appoint Wayne Dieck, Pete Pennington and Cindy Igl as alternates for the Board of Review. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,369.03, savings balance of \$295,327.44 and tax account balance of \$10.00 for a total of \$301,706.47.

Jon motioned to approve the Town of Antigo Volunteer Fire Department's request to apply for a 50/50 FFP Grant totaling \$2,302. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

The Board of Review will be held on Wednesday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. Gene Matuszewski will have his open book on Thursday, May 28<sup>th</sup> from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, June 10<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m.

All bills approved were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:20 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
