

**Town of Antigo
Public Budget Hearing
Special Town Meeting of the Electors
Monthly Board Meeting
November 16, 2010**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Public Budget Hearing to order on November 16, 2010 at 7 p.m. at the Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present were Assessor Gene Matuszewski, Roger Rohe, Verna Rohe and Ray Jankowski.

The proposed Budget of \$385,100 was reviewed. The budget is a 1.69% increase. Ray Jankowski motioned to adjourn the Public Budget Hearing. Gene Matuszewski seconded. There were 9 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Special Town Meeting of the Electors was called to order.

A motion was made by Roger Rohe to adopt Resolution #1-10 adopting the 2010 levy to be collected in 2011 in the amount of \$241,400. Ray Jankowski seconded. There were 9 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the Special Town Meeting of the Electors was made by Gene Matuszewski and seconded by Roger Rohe. There were 9 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Monthly Board Meeting was called to order.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Roger Rohe addressed the Board regarding his concerns with his neighbor, Armin Bork. Roger questioned the number of unlicensed vehicles that may be kept on a property and the Board told Roger he should check with the County Zoning office. Roger also questioned the junk ordinance which is also through the County. Rick will talk to Becky Frisch at the County Zoning office to see what can be done.

A motion was made by Jon to adopt the 2011 budget of \$385,100 for the Town of Antigo. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to appoint Gene Matuszewski as the Town Assessor for the 3-year period June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2014. Wages paid will be \$17,328 for the 6/1/11 – 5/31/12 year; \$13,488 for the 6/1/12 – 5/31/13 year; and \$13,488 for the 6/1/13 – 5/31/14 year. These wages will include Open Book and the Board of Review. Gene has agreed to keep the town in compliance with the state. Gene also agrees to: adhere to all State of Wisconsin statutory requirements; value all new construction; complete the assessment roll; current year use value guidelines for agricultural assessment; and the town providing stamps, pictures, etc. For the first year, the town will pay \$507 for the computer program and \$260 for support. For the second and third years, the town will pay for the computer program which should be \$507 besides any increase in the number of parcels. Wayne seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Fire protection contracts with Polar and Price were presented. Wayne motioned to sign the contract with Polar for \$9,813 plus the EMS charge of \$183 and with Price for

\$8,859 plus the EMS charge of \$45. Jon seconded. Motion carried. Contracts were signed and will be sent to Polar and Price for their signatures.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,354.97, savings balance of \$365,304.38 and tax account balance of \$77.13 for a total of \$371,736.48.

Wayne motioned to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Emergency Ambulance Services with the City of Antigo for \$58,268 for 2011. Rick seconded. Jon abstained. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Thursday, December 9th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Jon at 9:35 p.m. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.
