

**Town of Antigo
Public Budget Hearing
Special Town Meeting of the Electors
Monthly Board Meeting
November 17, 2009**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Public Budget Hearing to order on November 17, 2009 at 7 p.m. at the Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl. Also present were Assessor Gene Matuszewski, Edith Marmes, Jennifer Marmes, Jim Tatro, Tom Dieck, Mary Dieck and Ray Jankowski.

The Proposed Budget of \$378,700 was reviewed. The budget is a 1.26% increase. Gene Matuszewski motioned to adjourn the Public Budget Hearing. Tom Dieck seconded. There were 12 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Special Town Meeting of the Electors was called to order.

A motion was made by Tom Dieck to adopt Resolution #3-09 adopting the 2009 levy to be collected in 2010 in the amount of \$237,700. Gene Matuszewski seconded. There were 12 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the Special Town Meeting of the Electors was made by Tom Dieck and seconded by Ray Jankowski. There were 12 ayes and no nays. Motion carried.

The Monthly Board Meeting was called to order.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Jon and second by Wayne. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Wayne to adopt the 2010 budget of \$378,700 for the Town of Antigo. Jon seconded. Motion carried.

Town residents present had questions regarding the Langlade County's Water and Land Use Planning Committee's revisions to the zoning maps and specifically regarding zoning changes from A-1 to A-2. The Public Hearing is November 18th at 5 p.m. in the Wolf River Room of the Langlade County Resource Center.

Fire protection contracts with Polar and Price were presented. Jon motioned to sign the contract with Polar for \$9,481 plus the EMS charge of \$619 and with Price for \$8,559 plus the EMS charge of \$151. Wayne seconded. Motion carried. Contracts were signed and will be sent to Polar and Price for their signatures.

Lance VanPrice appeared before the Board with his request to create two parcels less than three acres in size. His business and home have been combined as one parcel in the past. It is hard to insure since combined. Matteks sold him 50 feet so he would have the County's one acre minimum for each lot. Lance put in a new septic in the house to split the property. Wayne motioned to approve Lance VanPrice's request to waive the Town of Antigo's Ordinance for a three acre minimum lot size. Lance will be creating a one acre lot with the house and a one acre lot with the business. Jon seconded. Motion carried. A copy of the minutes will be forwarded to Becky Frisch.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$6,344.86, savings balance of \$277,344.51 and tax account balance of \$99.98 for a total of \$283,789.35.

Rick received an estimate of \$1,038 from Langlade County for road brushing on Dorr Street, Industrial Park Road and North Clermont Street. Rick requested a quote from Shane Krueger at Krueger & Stienfest but did not receive one. Jon motioned to accept the estimate from Langlade County of \$1,038 for road brushing Dorr Street, Industrial Park Road and North Clermont Street. Rick seconded. Motion carried.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Wednesday, December 9th at 7:30 p.m.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:20 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
