

**Town of Antigo
Town Board Meeting
October 11, 2011**

Chairperson Rick Parilek called the Monthly Board Meeting to order on October 11, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. at the Antigo Town Hall. Other Board members present were Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi and Treasurer Cindy Igl.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior month's meeting. The minutes were approved with a motion by Wayne and second by Jon. Motion carried.

Tim Prunty and Beth Bockes were present as representatives of the Unified School District of Antigo. There is a November 8th referendum for a new elementary school and they discussed the reasons for the referendum and answered questions the Board had.

The Board received an Application for Minor Subdivision from Tim Keen. The Board contacted the surveyor, Charley Brinkmeyer, who stated that Tim Keen wants to create an 8.76 acre site for a new home. He currently has a home east of the 8.76 acres that he will be selling to his parents. Jon motioned to approve Tim Keen's Application for Minor Subdivision for an 8.76 acre lot. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Jon to sign the Agreement as to Delinquent Special Assessments and Charges with Langlade County. Wayne seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report showed a checking balance of \$3,249.65, savings balance of \$454,139.67 and tax account balance of \$54.22 for a total of \$457,443.54.

The Budget Workshop will be held on Monday, October 24th at 7:30 p.m.

There will be a school referendum election on November 8th.

Our next Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 15th following the 7 p.m. Public Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting of the Electors.

All approved bills were paid.

A motion was made to adjourn by Wayne at 9:45 p.m. Jon seconded. Motion carried.
