

**Town of Antigo
Annual Town Meeting
April 16, 2009**

The Annual Town Meeting was called to order on April 16, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Parilek. Ten town residents were present.

Rick introduced the current elected officials including Supervisor Jon Petroskey, Supervisor Wayne Schroeder, Clerk Rosemary Servi, Treasurer Cindy Igl, Assessor Gene Matuszewski and Constable Daryl Rasmussen. Also introduced was Steve Koss, County Supervisor for Ward 1.

The clerk read the minutes of the prior year's minutes. Rick added that last year a written donation request was received from the Spring Valley Little League team and a \$300 donation was made. No written request was received from the Town of Antigo Little League team. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Daryl Rasmussen and seconded by Bob Lynett. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 7 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

The Town's 2008 Annual Financial Report was reviewed. Gene Matuszewski motioned to accept the financial report as presented. Daryl Rasmussen seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 9 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Daryl Rasmussen gave the fire department's annual report. He stated that the fire department has had 15 fire runs and 15 EMS calls. The Town of Polar has purchased a new pumper truck.

Jon Petroskey, Fire Chief for the City of Antigo, gave the ambulance report. They had 1,757 calls in 2008 with 56 of them being in the Town of Antigo. They currently have 17 paramedics on their staff.

Rick stated that a written request was received from the Town of Antigo Little League team asking for a donation and stating that they will clean town roadways. Steve Koss motioned to donate \$500 to the Town of Antigo Little League team and \$300 to the Spring Valley Little League team if a written request is received from them. Gene Matuszewski seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 10 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Rick stated that the town did not get the Block Grant applied for through the Antigo Housing Authority last year. The town is reapplying again this year.

A motion to set next year's annual meeting on Thursday, April 15, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. was made by Daryl Rasmussen and seconded by Gene Matuszewski. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 9 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.

Being no further business, a motion was made to adjourn at 8:10 p.m. by Bob Lynett. Gene Matuszewski seconded. A show of hands vote was taken. There were 9 in favor. No one opposed. Motion carried.
