The regular monthly Town Board meeting, as posted at Mike's Service, Bob and Joni's Northern Lights, Strong's and the Town hall, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and William Majest, Linda Frank, treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, clerk. Townspeople Mike and Sharon Steckbauer were also present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Minutes of the November meeting were approved upon motion by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Linda Frank. The report was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Unfinished Business: Wabeno Mutual Aid Contract- Discussion on the mutual aid agreement that was presented from the Wabeno Fire Department for the Ada Lake portion of our township. Discussion to see if the Town of Langlade would handle the Ada Lake area for us. The Clerk will talk to fire Chief Alex Emerich about this matter.

New Business: B & B Disposal Contract. The board is very happy with the way B & B takes care of the township and wants to extend its contract with them. Discussion followed. . Upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest the contract with B & B Disposal will be renewed, motion carried. Representatives from B & B will attend the January meeting and will discuss tonnage and recycling totals at this meeting.

2011 Caucus – The Clerk inquired if all current board members would be seeking reelection. All board members and the clerk and treasurer will all be seeking reelection. The Notification of Non-Candidacy" will not be filed. The Caucus is set for Saturday, January 8, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

2011-2012 Election Board: The clerk read the current list of election workers to the board. The list includes Sharon Wilson, Jan Mabry, Rosie Kruse, JoAnn Rudolph, Deanna Mabry, Edith Prigge, Pat Lintonen and Karen Sellers. High School students will be called when needed. Motion to approve the election board was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

General Building and Plant – The state approved the new highway entrance for the fire department. This will be taken care of after paperwork has been received. A new chimney cap has been put on. Plexiglas sheets have been put over the air vents in the hall and can be removed when the hall is being heated.

Highway – Equipment is all ready for winter snowplowing.

Fire Department – They are having an open house this Saturday from 12 noon to 4 p.m. The fire department appreciation dinner is set for January 13, 2011 at 5 p.m. at the Woodshed.

Recycling Center – Jim Summerford discussed the contract with the Lakewood Rescue Squad. A new agreement has been set up and the Pickeral Rescue Squad will be doing the first response to the Ada Lake area for Troutland Rescue. A mutual aid agreement for this purpose was signed by the board and will be presented to the Pickeral Rescue Squad for their signatures. Jim also gave an update on the runs made by Troutland, the equipment they would like to purchase and their mutual aid agreement with Antigo.

Recycling/Disposal Center – Everything running well

Cemetery – Their will be a funeral this Saturday.

Correspondence – All current correspondence was discussed with the board.

Bills – All bills presented for payment were approved upon motion by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.
