

July 13, 2011

The regular monthly town board meeting as advertised in the Antigo Daily Journal and posted at Mike's service, Bob's Northern Lights and Strong's, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Casper Bduettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and William Majest. Also present were Mike and Sharon Steckbauer and David Peterson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.

Minutes of the June meeting were approved after the following correction. Blackwell Job Corp. will be here to paint sometime between July 15th and August 1st. Thereafter the motion to approve the minutes was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Treasurer Linda Frank. Motion to approve the report was made by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.

Non-board member business: Dave Peterson, representing the Village and the 4th of July parade committee, came to thank the town and the town board for their donation and continued support. He stated that anyone can be on the committee. Discussion followed on what the July 4th weekend brings to the community. The board complimented the parade committee for its work.

Unfinished Business – Mutual Aid with Wabeno is no longer. Paperwork is being completed with the Pickeral Fire Department and they shall be providing mutual aid in the Ada Lake area on a pay per run basis.

Extended warranty for new tractor – Reisterer and Schnell was contacted regarding the cost of the extended warranty. The cost would be \$2310.00 for full machine coverage. The limited plan is \$1319 for the engine and powertrain. The chairman will call Reisterer and Schnell to find out how long we have to get the extended warranty. If we cannot wait to get the warranty – we will have to purchase it now.

Highway – a garage door is needed for the last stall in the highway building. The cost for the opener would be \$600. Alex will be able to install this. Motion to purchase the opener was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried. Supervisor Majest mentioned that he had been to a Lakes Association meeting at Silver Birch. Some of the people on the lake would like to see more buoys installed close to the shoreline because of boaters. Discussion followed. People need to know the boating regulations so they stay the correct distance from the shore. People were told to call the DNR with their complaints. Questions were raised on residences with or without septic systems. The clerk is checking in on the matter. Fire number installation is nearing completion. Paving on town roads and the town hall parking lot will be starting around August 1st. Discussion on placement of 45 M.P.H. speed

limit sign. It should be placed well before coming into Langlade. The Department of Transportation was asked about this.

General Building and Plant – Discussion on work done around hall and what has yet to be done. The bulletin board will go back up as soon as the awning is complete. It will go under the awning near the office door.

Fire Department – Discussion on piping that will be going in by Silver Birch Ranch for new dry hydrant. Hydrant will benefit all properties on Sawyer Lake Road. Fire Chief Alex Emerich told about the success of the ticket raffle and corn roast and dunk tank. The department should see a profit of around \$5,000.00. The dunk tank is used by other charity events.

Rescue Squad – nothing new to report.

Recycling Center – Everything is going well. Larry Bolstad thanks the board for being able to switch hours with Jeff Steinbach, when he had to do extra training for his job in Antigo.

Cemetery – Rick is doing a good job. The question was raised as to whether Rick will be trimming the hedges or not. Rick will be asked if he would like to do this. A trimmer may have to be purchased.

Correspondence was reviewed. Insurance renewal papers have to be completed and returned to Laub and Horton this next week.

Bills for July were approved for payment upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.
