May 11, 2010

The regular monthly board meeting, as advertised in the Antigo Daily Journal and posted at the town hall, Mike's Service, Bob's Northern Lights and Strong's was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Casper Buettner. Also present were Supervisors Susan Hawley and William Majest, Linda Frank, treasurer and Mary Lee Heise, clerk. Townspeople were also in attendance.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by those present.

The agenda was approved upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Minutes of the April meeting were approved upon motion by Supervisor Majest and seconded by Supervisor Hawley, motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given by Linda Frank. Motion to approve the report was made by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest, motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

Housing Authority grant ó nothing new has been received as to the status of this matter.

Pick up of tires already at the recycling center ó The town wants to get rid of the semi trailer at the recycling center and there are tires in it that have been picked up over the years. American Tire out of Niagara has been contacted and they will be picking them up.

Painting of Hall ó Blackwell Job Corp. has been contacted and they anticipate being able to do the job at the end of July or August.

Non-board member business: None

New Business: Chairman needs permission to talk to Robert Walters concerning land behind the town's highway building. This matter will be on the June agenda.

General Building and Plant ó the painting of the town hall was again discussed. In addition, Blackwell will clean the outside of the building prior to painting. Their woodshop department will be constructing scaffolding at that time.

Highway ó The new mower with brushing and mowing attachments is currently in use, and working well. Roads that have already been brushed were discussed. The review of the town

roads took place on the 7th. Northeast Asphalt will be asked to measure work to be done. Bid will then be published in paper. 2011 projects were also decided on the 7th. Discussion followed on information received from Badger State Industries concerning fire number signs. Badger State Industries is run by the Department of Corrections. The price lists they have sent the town for the fire number signs appear to be considerably lower. More information will be obtained.

Rescue Squad: Nothing new to report.

Fire Department 6 Pumper brakes locked up. The truck was taken to Quinlan's for repair. The portable fire house that was used for the weekend blew a tire on its trip back to Antigo. Our department had the tires replaced. We will be reimbursed by the Antigo fire department.

Recycling Center: A letter was received from the Department of Natural Resources letting the town know that we will receive \$3345.36 as a recycling grant this year. This is based on the recycling grant forms filed online. The clerk discussed a recycling meeting she attended in the Town of Rolling last month and the educational materials that were available through the Department of Natural Resources. The town is still waiting for the tires to be picked up at the recycling center. Once the tires have been picked up the semi trailer will be removed by B & B Disposal and a new building will be dropped off. B & B will also be removing the little trailer. The new building will hold the waste oil containers that are dropped off and some other recyclables. Mike Steckbauer will be picking up the waste oil periodically. George Rock inquired if there is a fire extinguisher at the recycling center. This will be checked on as well as finding out if a first aid kit is available.

Cemetery:

Discussion on the work Mike Klimoski has done at the cemetery. When his work is complete new maps will be made showing all gravesites and ownership.

Correspondence:

A letter was read from the attorney for Mr. and Mrs. Schaller concerning their property. A copy of this letter was sent to the assessor. A letter will be sent to their attorney directing them to come to the open book and board of review set for June 11th. A letter was read from Verizon concerning service being changed to Frontier. A letter was read from Wisconsin Public Service concerning a Biomass fired Cogeneration Facility in Rothschild. Insurance papers were presented for review. Insurance will be discussed again in June.

Bills were approved for payment upon motion by Supervisor Hawley and seconded by Supervisor Majest.
