Lloyd Larson is a representative of the Wolf River Territory and is concerned about the current bike trails. He asked if more routes will be opened for ATV travel. He would not like the route on Sauls Springs Road opened because it crosses the existing bike trail. The current ATV route would be Highway 64 to Sauls Springs, past Setting Lake to South Branch of the Oconto River and up over the hill. There is a burm and it looks as though the ATVs are going up over it onto the bike trail. Mr. Larson was instructed to contact the Doty ATV Club.

Mr. Gagne from Miller Lane questioned the board concerning trespassing issues and bear hunters.

Unfinished Business: Blackwell Job Corp ó Roof is done. The board is hoping that Blackwell will be able to paint our hall yet this year. They will instruct us as to what to order as soon as the painting job is scheduled.
