

**LANGLADE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS
SCHEDULE OF LICENSE FEES AND CHARGES**

West Grounds Only: (includes the use of the area lying between Hwy. 45/Superior Street and the fairgrounds road running between Arctic Street and North Avenue).

Racetrack Grandstand & Grounds (includes a \$ 50/day fee for the P.A. system)

Livestock Pavilion: (includes the use of the Center Pavilion and 2 Wings)

*Maintenance Department staff will cook out the French fryer after every use at a cost of **\$25.00 per hour**.

**Use of kitchen for food service only requires license to use a building or grounds.

All users will be required to submit a deposit of one day's rent for their event. Additionally, for the use of the racetrack, a deposit of **\$ 500** is required to guarantee the track is put back to a satisfactory condition as determined by the County. Deposits are held against and applied to event charges with any surplus returned to the user. If the event is

cancelled without requisite notice, then any deposits will be forfeited. Langlade County reserves the right to change the above-listed fee schedule for special use events.

Use of Public Address System: If not using the racetrack, a fee of \$ 50/day is charged for the use of the P.A. System.

Well Charge: \$ 50/week if water is used on the grounds or \$100/day if the water is used off the fairgrounds property and signed liability waiver.

Utilities: Users will be billed for utilities (electric, gas) based upon the rate established by the utility for the previous month.

Dumpsters: The County will provide two dumpsters for each event (1 for recyclables, 1 for garbage). The User will be responsible for the costs of any additional dumpsters requested for their event.

Restroom Cleaning and Janitorial Supply Fee for Multipurpose Building: For any licensed event that includes the use of restroom facilities, a flat fee of \$ 100 for any single day event. For multiple day events, an additional fee of \$ 50 will be charged for each consecutive event day.

Maintenance Department Charges: Users will be charged a minimum of 1-hour for a Maintenance staff worker to return to the Fairgrounds for any reason after their normal working hours. Maintenance staff currently works from 6:00 am – 2:30 pm (M-F). Users are encouraged to handle event issues during their scheduled work hours. Langlade County will furnish custodial service for the purpose of locking and unlocking doors and securing county-owned equipment at a cost of \$ 25.00 per hour.

Cleaning Fees: If the facilities and/or grounds are not cleaned to the satisfaction of the County, then the user will be charged for cleaning at a cost of \$ 25.00 per hour to have the maintenance department staff clean the facilities. (When applicable), if the Pavilion is not sanitized within the prescribed time limit or sanitized properly, then the County will charge the user for the costs of sanitization (approx. \$1000).

Snow Removal Fees: Snow plowing for any space or road on the grounds and grading of the race track not normally maintained by the county will be at the expense of the user.

ALL BILLS MUST BE PAID BY USER WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS FROM RECEIPT. AFTER THIRTY (30) DAYS, LANGLADE COUNTY MAY ASSESS A LATE PAYMENT FEE OF 1.5% PER MONTH.
