3. Recite the Pledge of Allegiance and please silence all cell phones.
4. Approve/amend the minutes: Motion by Curler, second by Clark to approve the previous meeting minutes of March 13, 2025. All ayes, motion carried.
5. Brief introductions: Those in attendance did introductions.
6. Legislator Reports: Cronin, Representative Tiffany’s Office, stated the Congressman is continuing on removing the Grey Wolf from the endangered species list, FEMA Safer Grant Program, met with Great Lakes Timber Professionals in Washington DC, honored the passing of a vet, renaming a Post Office after the vet, Academy Day is July 12 in Wausau, WPS Commission Keeping the Lights on Act, and other activities for the Congressman Tiffany.
7. Delmore Consulting LLC, Road Consulting Service: Robbie Hale: Hale provided a handout of the services offered by Delmore Consulting: Road Surface Conditions, Roadwork Bid Letting, Paser Ratings, Inventory and Mapping, providing data to better utilize your budgets.
8. Discuss the Storm Recovery from the March 31 and April 1, 2025 Storm: Travis Krueger, Emergency Management Director, provided a handout after information was requested post-storm on: planning, shelters, reimbursements, and other general information. Krueger provided information on townhalls as a shelter and Towns purchasing generators through a grant. Krueger also included information on the Wisconsin Disaster Fund. Discussion held.
9. Broadband Update: Economic Development Director Angie Close provided an update on the current broadband projects in Langlade County: Town of Neva household connections to be completed in July, the last grant-

funded project. Town of Summit Tower Project, a 300-foot tower that will have tower tenants. Close also discussed the BEAD Program, as the Feds have just updated the program again, making fiber, wireless, and satellite options included in the program.

10. **WTA Director Reports:** Jackie Beyer: Beyer provided a legislative update, a budget update, ARIP and TRIP, bootcamp for town clerks, clerk college in July, MOE reports due, ARPA Funding reports, DOR reports. Beyer also provided a list of 2025/2026 Legislative Priorities.

12. **New Business:** Antoniewicz discussed the public records request from Sunlight Report, asking to be included in the agenda distribution for all town and county meetings. Curler discussed the TAD Meetings, Hope House, and Broken Arrow. Curler provided a handout of the Langlade County Resources available for drug and alcohol issues. Curler stated that the Langlade County Silt Loam and Water's Community Wide Field day is June 27, 2025.
