#### **DISEASE UPDATES:**

In the **last two weeks:**

- ✓ The Burden of Illness for Langlade County is 156.7 per 100,000 and the case activity remains **HIGH**. (WI Burden of Illness is 155.6 per 100,000 and case activity is still high).

Between 4/24/2021 and 4/30/2021:

- ✓ 9 new cases of COVID-19 were reported to Langlade County Health Department.
- ✓ Age groups represented: < 18, 25-34, 35-44, 65+

To date, the Langlade County Health Department has not been notified of any variants identified in the county.

#### **VACCINATION UPDATES:**

The CDC Advisory Committee voted to lift the pause on the Johnson & Johnson vaccine and the WI Department of Health Services (DHS) is resuming distribution of this vaccine. The Langlade County Health Department is in the process of reviewing the updated recommendations.

The community-based vaccination clinic in the state remains open in Marathon County at the Northcentral Technical College in Wausau and is open Tuesday through Saturday, from 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Individuals must register for an appointment using the Wisconsin COVID-19 Vaccine Registry at <https://vaccinate.wi.gov/en-US/>

#### **STATE AND COUNTY DATA: As of Friday April 30, 2021:**

- 43.1% of Wisconsin residents have received at least **one** dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 80.8% of Wisconsinites aged 65 and over have received at least one dose of vaccine.
- 36.6% of Langlade County residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 73.1% of Langlade County residents aged 65 and over have received at least one dose of vaccine.
- In total (first and second doses) 12,406 doses have been given to Langlade County residents.
