

FARES ONE-WAY

You must pay a fare each time you board the bus. Children from birth to 2 years of age ride free!

Antigo In-City route is a flex route that runs with a fixed schedule. The flex route will deviate up to 2 blocks for elders and disabled riders who call ahead for the deviation. Schedule and map can be found inside.

Antigo Rural route is a door to door service that serves an 8 mile radius from the center of the city. Map of the service area can be found inside. This service is based on driver and vehicle availability and is a shared ride service.

Langlade Co. route is a door to door service that serves all of Langlade County. This service is based on driver and vehicle availability and is a shared ride service.



RULES

- Good manners are required when riding the bus and passengers must not disturb others or the safety of the bus service.
- Wait on the proper side of the roadway for the bus to make a complete stop before approaching the bus.
- Enter the bus with exact fare.
- Please allow elders to use the front seats first.
- The driver may refuse transportation to a person who is intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.
- Do not change seats after the bus starts moving.
- Baggage and other carry-on items must fit under the rider's seat or be placed on the rider's lap.
- Collapsible baby strollers, band instruments and small coolers are limited to one per person.
- No gasoline, batteries or other flammable or caustic materials are allowed on the bus.
- Menominee Department of Transit Services reserves the right to suspend bus service for passengers who do not follow these rules.
- Absolutely no smoking in or around any Menominee Department of Transit Services vehicles.
- Riders may utilize personal radios, cassette players, CD players, DVD/Movie players with headphones, as to not impede on drivers ability to safely hear traffic and two – way radio communications.

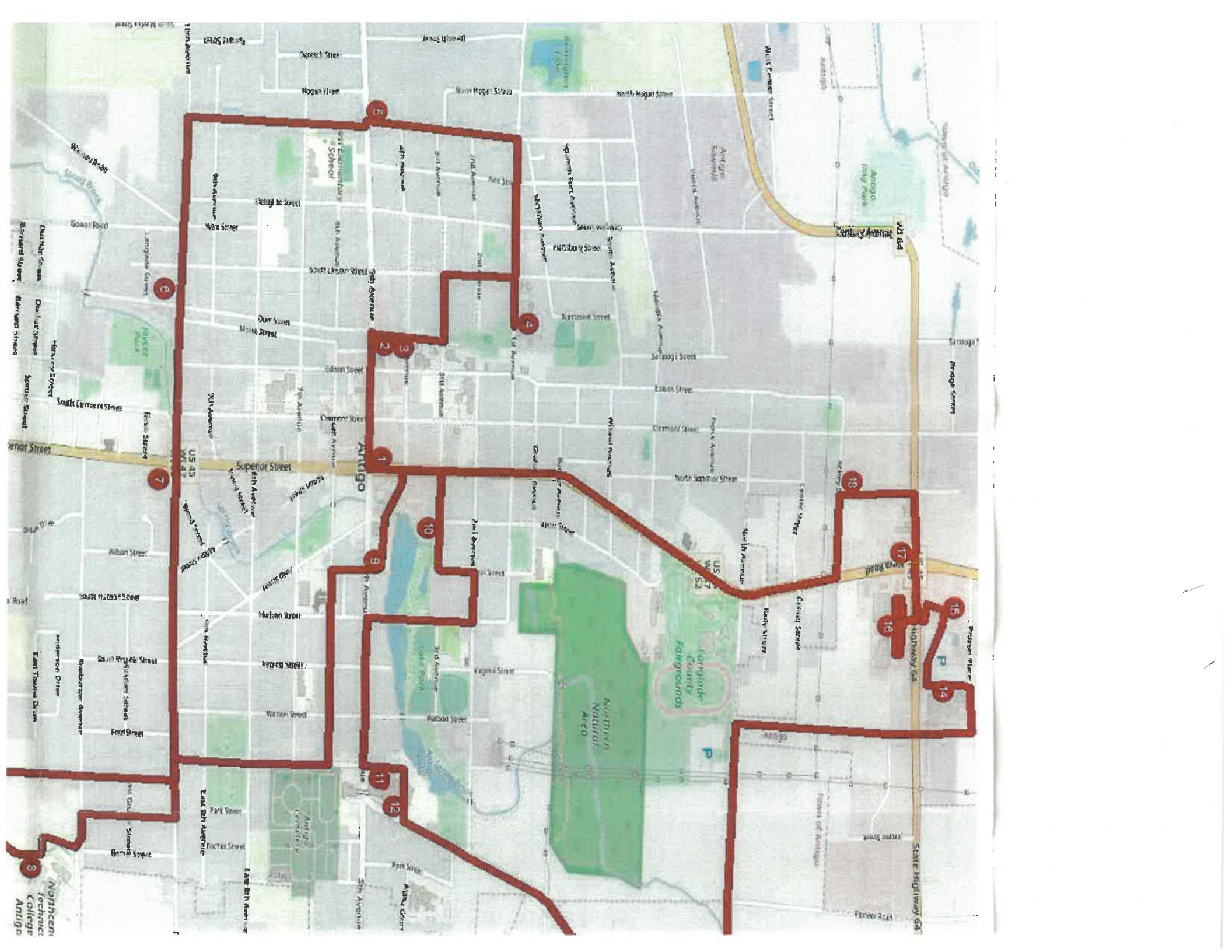

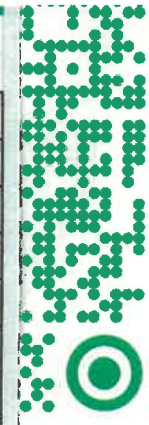

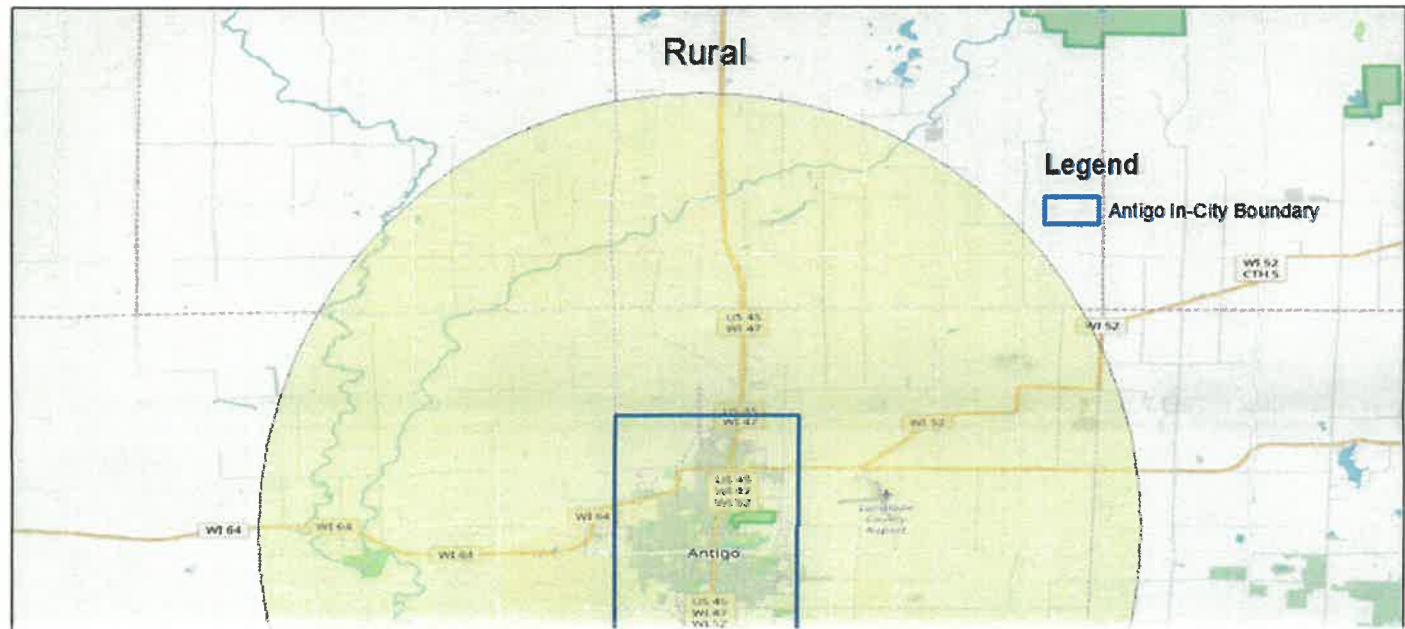
