Clean Sweep Guidelines

- ⇒ **DO NOT MIX MATERIALS TOGETHER**
- ⇒ Materials must be left in their original containers for identification.
- ⇒ If original container is damaged, place container and contents in a cardboard box lined with a plastic bag.
- ⇒ Farms and agricultural entities are eligible for the Agricultural Clean Sweep.
- ⇒ Active/abandoned farms and agricultural business can participate.
- ⇒ Langlade County residents are eligible for the Household Clean Sweep.
- ⇒ Non-agricultural businesses can participate for a fee.

- Chemical Information**
 - Gallons of liquid chemicals?
 - Pounds of solid chemicals?
 - If over 50 gal. or 500 lb. provide trade or chemical name.
 - Any 30 or 55 gal. drums?
 - How many drums and what is in each drum?
 - Are any drums ready to rupture or break?
 - Any unknown chemicals?
 - Any special waste (e.g. mercury or PCB's) requiring disposal?
 - Do you need on-site pickup for leaking/damaged containers?
 - If yes, explain.
 - Preferred drop-off time.

Agricultural Clean Sweep

Agricultural Clean Sweep is a **FREE** program designed to assist agricultural producers to properly dispose of hazardous materials.

PRE-REGISTRATION is required for the Agricultural Clean Sweep.

Examples of agricultural materials accepted:

Herbicide Items:

Atrazine, 2 4-D, Dual, Round-up, Banvel, Sencor.

Insecticide Items:

Counter, Diazinon, Dyfonate, Sevin, Furadan, Temik, Thimet, Lorsban, Lead Arsenate, DDT, Malathian, Chloridane.

Fungicide Items:

Captan, Benlate, Funginex, Methyl Bromide, Manzate, Dithane, Phostoxin, EDB.

Rodenticide Items:

Warfarin, Strychnine, Zinc Phosphide, Arsenicals.

Other Farm Chemical Items:

Solvents, Animal Health Products, Dairy Acids, Degreasers, Wood Finishes, Paint Additives, Hydraulic Fluids.

Household Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep

This **FREE** program is designed to assist households in proper disposal of hazardous materials.

No registration or appointment needed for the Household Clean Sweep.

Examples of materials accepted:

Household Items:

Aerosols, Spray Paints, Solvent Based Cleaners, Furniture/Floor Care Products, Metal Polishes, Rug & Upholstery Cleaners, Spot Removers, Plumbing Cleaners.

Automotive Items:

Antifreeze, Auto Body Repair Products, Brake Fluids, Car Wax (solvent bases), Degreasing Chemicals, Gas-Line Deicers, Left-Over Fuels, Transmission Fluid.

Pesticide, Herbicide, Fungicide Items:

Weed Killers, Insecticides, Fungicides, Mothballs, Rat/Mouse Poisons (arsenic based), and Pet Health Products.

Paint, Glue, Solvent Items:

Contact Cement, Driveway Sealers, Oil-Based Paints, Lead-Based Paints, Stains, Strippers, Paint Thinners, Varnish, Wood Preservatives.

Other Items:

Stump Removal Chemicals, Photo Processing Chemicals, Pool Chemicals.

Non-agricultural, Small Business Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep

A non-agriculture small business program is available for a **FEE**.

PRE-REGISTRATION is required for the Non-agricultural, Small Business Clean Sweep.

Pharmaceutical Clean Sweep

This is a **FREE** program to assist in the proper disposal of medications. The flushing of medication down the drain or placing them in the trash may contaminate ground and surface waters.

No registration or appointment needed for the medication disposal.

- ⇒ Bring in unused and unwanted medication for proper disposal.
- ⇒ Bring medications in the original container.
- ⇒ Black out any personal information.
- ⇒ Do not block out the name of the medication.

NO needles, thermometers, nebulizers, or radioactive medication

There is a local medication drop box available 24/7 in the lobby of the Langlade County Safety Building.
