TRASH AND RECYCLING GUIDELINES

The trash and recycling center is open for Summit residents and land owners the **second and last Saturday of each month from 8:00 am until 1:00 pm**. Depositing trash or recycling outside of the scheduled hours requires permission from a town official or representative. Failure to obtain permission could result in a fine. You are being recorded via security cameras.

FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN LOCKED DUMPSTERS

Acceptable Recycling Items:

- **Plastic**
 - Household bottles, jars, & jugs – Flatten Plastic Bottles if possible
 - Dairy containers & lids
 - Produce, bakery, & deli containers & lids
- **Paper**
 - Cardboard & Paperboard (food boxes) – Flatten Boxes
 - Newspaper & inserts
 - Office and school paper
 - Envelopes, junk mail, & catalogs
 - Books & magazines
 - Milk, juice, & soup cartons – Flatten if possible
- **Glass**
 - Food & beverage bottles & jars
 - **Not recyclable but can be placed in trash:**
 - **Window Glass**
 - **Ceramics & China**
 - **Drinking Glassware**
- **Metal**
 - Aluminum bottles & cans
 - Steel & tin cans
 - **Not acceptable for recycling at Recycling Center:**
 - **Aluminum pans and foil**
 - **Empty paint cans with dried or liquid paint**

Trash Items:

- Normal household trash and food items
- Polystyrene packaging (for serving food or beverages), Loose particles intended for packing (i.e. packing peanuts), rigid foam for cushioning packaged material
- Clothing and textile items
- Batteries
 - Alkaline (Manganese) (AAA, AA, C, D, 6V, 9V)
 - Carbon Zinc (AAA, AA, C, D, 6V, 9V)
 - Zinc-air (Button, 9V)
 - Silver Oxide (Sizes vary)
- Aluminum pans and foil
- Empty paint cans with dried paint

Recycling - at Drop off Recycling Centers (see <https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Recycling>):

- **Electronics**
- **Lead Acid Batteries**
- **Dry Batteries**
 - Lithium ion batteries contained in electronics Laptops, cellphones, notebooks, tablets, computer peripherals, other portable electronics with screens
- **Major Appliances**
- **Used Oil Filters**
- **Waste Oil**
- **Waste Tires**
- **Yard Waste**

Items not allowed in Trash or Recycling:

- **Propane tanks or large steel cylinders**
- **Scrap metal (large pipes, structural steel)**
- **Metal cookware**
- **Large Metal components (engine, vehicle, machinery parts)**
- **Liquids such as paint (see above for exception), oil, antifreeze, solvents**
- **Cords, hoses, wires, strings of lights, heavy ropes**
- **Needles & sharps**
- **Animal Carcasses or Hides**
