

Employment Opportunity for Langlade County Sheriff's Office

The Sheriff of Langlade County is conducting an application process to fill a full-time vacancy and establish an eligibility list for any future vacancies for full-time position(s) of "Deputy Sheriff".

- Salary and Benefits: Starting wage as of January 1, 2024 is \$27.72 per hour. Benefits include uniform allowance, vacation, sick leave, holiday pay, longevity pay, health and life insurance, voluntary disability insurance, and Wisconsin Retirement Fund
- Lateral Transfer available for experienced personnel
- 1-year introductory period

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older
- U.S. Citizen
- Hold a valid Wisconsin Drivers License
- Possess either an associate degree in police science from a Wisconsin vocational, technical and adult education district or it's accredited equivalent from another state, or a minimum of 60 fully accredited college-level credits
- Be certifiable as a law enforcement officer at time of appointment (clearly indicate if or when you will become certified or certifiable as a law enforcement officer by the state of Wisconsin)
- Must meet other minimum recruitment standards of the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Standards Board
- Must be in good physical condition and be able to perform essential job functions of a law enforcement officer
- Must successfully pass a written examination and oral interviews
- Must pass drug screening tests and background investigation
- Must pass psychological and medical/physical exam
- Must pass Physical agility test
