IN WISCONSIN, IT IS ILLEGAL TO DISCRIMINATE IN RENTING OR HOUSING BECAUSE OF:

- AGE
- ANCESTRY
- COLOR
- DISABILITY
- FAMILY STATUS
- LAWFUL SOURCE OF INCOME
- STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC ABUSE, SEXUAL ABUSE, OR STALKING
- MARITAL STATUS
- NATIONAL ORIGIN
- RELIGION
- RACE
- SEX
- SEXUAL ORIENTATION
