2. **Approve minutes from last meeting.** Lenzner stated in Old Business in A. to change Pelican Lake to Pickerel Lake. Motion by Bonacci, second by Osborne to approve the previous meeting minutes of February 21, 2019 with the corrected change. All ayes, motion carried.
3. **Old Business:**
  - A. **Fatalities in Langlade County:**

**Truck vs Snowmobile County Road H south of County Road Q on 02-09-2019.** Olig reviewed the accident on the Community Maps- Wisconsin County TSC Crash Mapping. It was stated on the accident report alcohol was a factor. Information only.
  - B. **Speed Board for the year Aug 13-Sept 9 for Langlade County:** Lenzner stated Langlade County will get the speed board from August 13 to September 9, 2019. Information only.
  - C. **USH 45 and County Road C:** Lenzner stated another accident has occurred at the intersection of USH 45 and County Road C. Highway Commissioner Braun stated CTH C is scheduled to be re-signed with stop ahead symbol signs on both sides of the road for westbound traffic. Sign distances will also be updated.
4. **Dot updates-** Olig updated the Committee on statistics on crashes within Langlade County. Olig showed the Committee the statistics on the Community Maps website. Discussion was held on teen drivers and the use of cell phones while driving. Osborne stated that no electronics use can be used with a probationary license, this also includes the hands free technology. Olig stated the Click it or Ticket Program starts May 20 through June 2, 2019. Information only.
