

**LANGLADE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING OF THE LANGLADE COUNTY BOARD – JUNE 26, 2023
COUNTY BOARD ROOM, LOWER LEVEL OF THE SAFETY BUILDING**

The Lantlade County Board of Supervisors met in the County Board Room, Lower Level of the Safety Building. Chairman Pierce called the June 26, 2023 Monthly Meeting of the County Board to order at 5:35 p.m. On call of the roll, 17 Supervisors present, 3 absent, and 1 vacancy. Absent: Supervisors Zaverousky, Bardo and Mulhollon. Motion by Supervisor Benishek, second by Supervisor J. Wagner to excuse Supervisors Zaverousky, Bardo and Mulhollon. All ayes, motion carried. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance and observed a moment of silence.

Board Participation in On-Line Safety/Security Training: No Course this month.

Joe Jopek, Ice Age Alliance: Jopek present history of the Ice Age, creating an awareness of continental glacier consequences, going back 31,500 years, as the glacier was in Lantlade County 19,500 years ago, and the ice leaving the State 11,000 years ago. Jopek discussed various lobes, deposits, and till that the glaciers dropped, creating such natural areas as National Scenic Trail, the Driftless Area and the Inner Continental Glacier Divide and the Antigo Flats. Discussion held. Jopek stated the National Park Service awarded him the 4000 Hour Award for his work with the Ice Age Alliance.

Update or Report on Grants and Activities from the County Administrator: County Administrator Hilger submitted a written report. Copy of the report is available from County Administrator Hilger. Other items not on the report included update on Broadband and UW Extension Regional Coordinator meeting to establish a relationship and goals for the County. County Administrator Hilger requested a Financial Literacy Program, partnering with other organizations to implement. Discussion on the County opening up all county roads to ATV/UTV use. Area Extension Director Lersch addressed the Board, speaking on the Strategic Plan for Extension, looking for public input. Lersch and the Research Station Field Day, July 6 Noon to 3.

County Board History Report from Supervisor Benishek: Supervisor Benishek continued with the history of the County Board going back to November 12, 1957. Benishek discussed per diems, leasing Kettle Bowl Ski Hill, creating County Park on Jack Lake. In 1960, Dam Project on the Wolf River approved, approved funding to start project and in March 1963, the Board approved WI Assembly Bill 442A, which prohibits building a dam on the Wolf River. In 1964,

funding was provided to Antigo Board of Vocational, Tech and Adult Education to establish a school in Langlade County Area and in June 1967, land was purchased to build a Technical College. In April, 1966, the County Board re-organized the County Board to 21 Supervisors, to which Supervisor Benishek now joined the Board. More to come.
