1. **Call meeting to order/ silence your cell phone.**
2. **The Committee recited the Pledge of Allegiance.**
3. **Approval of previous meeting minutes.** Motion by Feller Gottard, second by Novak to approve the previous meeting minutes of July 1 & July 8, 2019. All ayes, motion carried.
4. **A request was made for public comment on agenda items and the consideration of items to be added to future agendas.** None
5. **Non-routine business requiring discussion/action:**
  - a. **Stephanie Thiede, Health Department, discuss drinking water testing programs.**  
Thiede stated the Langlade County Health Department currently has well water test kits available for individuals who have children between the ages of 6 month and 16 years old in their household, and want their water tested for fluoride. When results are mailed back to you, the individual can bring the test results to the Langlade County Health Department to receive fluoride drops or tablets according to the age of the child and the test results. Thiede stated this program is grant funded.

McKay stated she has been in contact with Kevin Masarik, Center for Watershed Science and Education and he has offered to come and talk with the Committee. The Committee

agreed they would like to have Kevin Masarik come to the October Land & Water Use Meeting. Information only.

- b. **Land & Water Resource Management Plan review form.** McKay presented the Committee with a Land & Water Resource Management Plan review. The Committee reviewed the form, with discussion held. McKay stated the form will be reviewed at the October 1, 2019 by the Wisconsin Land Conservation Board.

Motion by Balcerzak, second by Buck to approve the Land & Water Resource Management Plan review form forwarding it onto the Wisconsin Land Conservation Board. All ayes, motion carried.

- c. **Conservation Camp Scholarship report.** Sam Heuss gave the Committee an update on the attendance of the Conservation Camp. Heuss thanked the Committee for the opportunity to attend the camp. McKay stated that Noah Detlaff also went to camp on scholarship but was unable to attend today's meeting.

- d. **Review 2020 Land Conservation budget.** McKay presented the Committee with a 2020 Budget. Discussion held on the 2020 budget and the 2021 preliminary budget. Motion by Novak, second by Buck to approve Land Conservation 2020 budget and forward it onto Finance Committee. All ayes, motion carried.

- 6. **Agency Reports:** McKay stated the DNR invites the public to take part in the Operation Deer Watch. Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources researchers ask participants to report their deer sightings via an easy-to-use online form. Participants are asked to record all bucks, does and fawns seen during the day from August 1 to September 30. Information only.

- 7. **Department update:** McKay stated DATCP did a Farmland Preservation review. McKay stated this review takes place every 4 years.

Supervisor Novak commended the Land Conservation Department on the culvert work being done at Moose Lake. Arrowood stated that they are still waiting on Frontier. Once Frontier locates their lines, then the digging can take place.

- 8. **Reports of events attended:** Novak updated the Committee on the attendance of the Enterprise Lake Meeting held on July 6, 2019.

Feller Gottard state the Post Lake Meeting was cancelled due to storm damage.
